For Your Information ...

- Golfing is prohibited on the premises. Please do not hit balls anywhere in the complex.
 - Pet Owners: Be sure to keep your pet on leash and accompanied at all times outside your apartment. And don't forget to clean up any mess your pet may make.
 - Remember, Grilling & Charcoaling is not permitted on the balconies. If you grill, please do so on the ground away from the buildings.
 - If you fish, please dispose of any and all disposable tackle. The ducks are getting entangled in fishing line. Also keep in mind, Trot Lines are prohibited.
 - PARENTS! Remember children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by you when near the lake or swimming pool (State Law). Also, remind your children to stay away from the ducks and geese nests and eggs.
 - If you own a vehicle parked on the premises that either doesn't run, doesn't have a Southlake Village ID sticker, has flat tires, or broken out glass, you will need to remove it from the lot or face having that vehicle towed.
