HELP US KEEP YOUR COMMUNITY CLEAN!

We take pride in making Southlake Village one of the cleanest and nicest communities in Wichita. As you may know, we pick up trash each day and mow lawns weekly. We also have a lake cleanup patrol but we still need your help in keeping things neat and clean. What can you do? Obviously, please don't litter. That includes not dumping ash trays in the parking lot. And when taking your trash to the dumpsters, please throw it in the dumpsters. Don't leave it sitting on the ground next to them. Also, if you take food or beverages to the lake, please remember to dispose of your trash appropriately. Lastly, if you live on the ground level, please keep your patio and surroundings clutter-free. (This is not a storage area.) It will really help us with the mowing. Thank you for your help and cooperation.

JULY 4TH REMINDER

We want to remind all residents that firework shooting is not permitted on the premises. This includes in the complex and parking lot, at the basketball and tennis courts, as well as and around the lake. We suggest you contact the Wichita Police Department to find out where firework shooting is permitted. (Some firework stands allow shooting of fireworks at their locations. Be sure to ask them first.) Have a safe and happy holiday!

For Your Information ...

- Golfing, baseball, and softball is prohibited on the premises. Please do not hit or throw balls anywhere in the complex.
- Pet Owners: Be sure to keep your pet on leash and accompanied at all times outside your apartment. And don't forget to clean up any mess your pet may make.
- Remember, Grilling & Charcoaling is not permitted on the balconies. If you grill, please do so on the ground away from the buildings.
- If you fish, please dispose of any and all disposable tackle. The ducks are getting entangled in fishing line. Also keep in mind, Trot Lines are prohibited.
- PARENTS! Remember children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by you when near the lake or swimming pool (State Law). Also, remind your children to stay away from the ducks and geese nests and eggs.
- If you own a vehicle parked on the premises that either doesn't run, doesn't have a Southlake Village ID sticker, has flat tires, or broken out glass, you will need to remove it from the lot or face having that vehicle towed. If you find that your car is missing, please contact the office so we may inform you of it's whereabouts.
