BLACKBERRY-FLAVORED ICED TEA

INGREDIENTS NEEDED:

4 CUPS HOT TEA (ORANGE, PEKOE OR DARJEELING) WORK REALLY WELL)
1 CUP BLACKBERRIES
HONEY TO TASTE

In a bowl, combine the hot tea with the blackberries. Let steep for one hour. With the back of a wooden spoon, crush the berries in the tea. Then pour the mixture through a fine strainer into a pitcher. Add honey to taste and chill for at least two hours. Serve over ice.

 - Remember, Grilling & Charcoaling is not permitted on the balconies. Wichita Fire Code 307.5 and 307.2 states that you cannot be within 10 feet of any building!!!
