






Southlake Village Lock-Out Policy

- During normal business hours (excluding holidays), residents may borrow a key at the office to let themselves in. There is no charge.
- Any other time, there is a \$20.00 fee for a representative to travel to resident's apartment and unlock the door. You must call our 24-hour number, 522-4855, to arrange service. Please pay representative at time of service.
- Also, you MUST be a resident who is on the lease. You MUST show photo I.D. to the representative. And you MUST leave a contact phone number with us!

Just a Few Reminders...

- For those of you who own pets, please remember to clean up after your pet. (A "pooper scooper" is a great tool for this!) And don't forget to keep your pet accompanied and on leash at all times.
- From our Security Patrol: Please notify your guests that parking in the carports is prohibited as they are RESERVED for the exclusive use of residents who lease them. All violators will be tagged and towed. Also, guests MUST be accompanied by residents at all times while using the facilities. Trespassers and unaccompanied guests will be asked to leave.
- Boat owners: Don't forget to empty your boats out after rainstorms. Stagnate water not only looks and smells bad, it also attracts bugs and small animals.
- If you are a smoker, please do not dispose of your ashes and butts in the parking lot, grounds, or pool area. Use a trash can and help keep your community clean.

How You Can Save Money on Electric Bills!


